SARAPO FAMILY WINES was born out of desire to save outstanding barrels of handcrafted wine from being sold to giant producers and blended into obscurity. *We do not "make" Sarapo wines from grape to bottle.* We seek out small lots made by other artisan winemakers to carefully blend our own limited-production wines of distinction and personality.

THE TEAM — Kent Humphrey (Winemaker of Eric Kent Wine Cellars) searches for the wines and creates the finished blends. Renee Humphrey manages wholesale operations, and Kent's wife Colleen Teitgen-Humphrey handles design and branding.

THE NAME — Sarapo is Kent and Renee's mother's maiden name, with various branches of the Italian family involved in wine for generations. With great admiration we give each wine a "family name" inspired by these relatives, both past and present.

Drink now through late 2014, or cellar it for a year or so longer and you should be pleasantly surprised!
